


2015 INTERGALACTIC FLYING SAUCER TRIALS



“Go For The Gold!” New and Revised

RULES

1. The Saucer:

- a. Must be round or nearly round on its outer edge
- b. Must be at least 8” in diameter
- c. Must have a thickness not more than ½ its diameter
- d. Must be unique and easily identifiable
- e. Must not be any pre-manufactured toy or flying device.

2. The Entry:

An entry consists of a saucer and its associated crew. The crew may consist of up to two (2) like-minded beings. There is a \$5.00 (US Earth currency) fee for each entry. This fee enters your saucer in the contest, entitles you to two launches (one launch per crew member), and provides two (2) “participant” tags for the crew

3. The Course:

The course is identified from the east side of the old Bridgeville Bridge to a landing spot on the river bar marked by a red circle with a pole in the center. (The Bridge is approximately 40 feet **ABOVE** the river bar; the goal is about 45 yards east.)

4. The Game:

The object of the contest is to land your saucer as close to the pole as possible. The winner will be the saucer that lies closest to the pole at the close of the contest. (Prizes will be awarded to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place saucers.) Each entry will get two (2) launches in the order of their entry. After the launch, the crew will have the option of either leaving the saucer where it landed or having it retrieved by

the ground crew for a second launch. To launch more than the two allotted attempts, the crew member must have a "Participant" tag and pay a retrieval fee of \$1.00. They will then join the line of launchers at the rear and wait their turn to re-launch. This can be repeated as many times as the crew wishes and a retrieval request can be made at any time by either crew member until the contest closes. At the appointed closing time, the launch line will be closed, but every being in the launch line will be allowed their last shot.

5. **The Launch:**

Saucers will be launched only from the official launch pad on the Bridge. Each entry will be allotted one (1) minute on the launch pad to launch their saucer. All forward momentum of the saucer must come directly from the hand of the crew member.

6. **The Prize:**

All Entry and Retrieval fees will be combined and 50% will go to the BCC. The other half will be divided amongst the first, second, and third place finishers in this order.

1st Place - 50%

2nd Place – 30 %

3rd Place – 20%

The winners will also receive an earthly trinket to adorn their garments.
